

Campground Rules and Regulations

- The campsite fee (\$69.00 Tax and Surcharge included) is per site for the entire weekend. 4 people per site. Additional bracelets can be purchased at \$20.00. Children under 12 are free.

The following Rules and regulations are implemented for your enjoyment

- Only ONE tent per site or ONE RV per site. A Canopy is acceptable
- **NO** pets permitted in the camping area, except registered service animals
- All campers must hold a valid concert ticket. Non-concert goers are not permitted inside the Camping Area. Campers will be wrist banded accordingly for admission in and out of the Camping Area. No visitors please.
- Porta potties will be available on site, however, campsites are not serviced. Campers are responsible for their own water and electricity. This includes drinking water. Campers wishing to bring a generator may do so.
- Campsites allotted upon arrival, campers wishing to be situated next to friends or family must arrive together as there will be no reserved sites.
- Transportation will be provided **FREE** of charge to and from centennial concert park
- All persons & Vehicles subject to search upon entry. Prohibited items, as listed below, are subject to surrender:
 - **NO** glass bottles permitted, only plastic or cans due to safety reasons
 - No ATVs, dirt bikes, golf carts or mopeds.
 - No drones
 - No public nudity
 - No campfires permitted, BBQs and camp stoves only
 - No fireworks, open flames or paper lanterns
 - No drugs or weapons of any kind. Possession of such items will result in immediate eviction from the campgrounds and notification of authorities.
 - No large stereo systems, campers must keep music to a moderate level as not to disturb other patrons.

- Please note you will not be able to travel back and forth between the camping Area and the concert area several times throughout the day as per our Concert Re-Entry Policy. Once you leave the concert you will not be permitted to re-enter the Concert Area that same day. You are however welcome to return to the campground early if you do not wish to stay until the end of the concert.
- Campers will be wrist banded upon entry. All campers must wear a wristband at all times. Those without wristbands will not be permitted to enter camping area.
- One vehicle per campsite
- In order to keep the campsite a safe environment, please refrain from unnecessary driving once situated on your campsite. Limit vehicle usage to emergencies only.
- Absolutely zero tolerance for drinking and driving. Intoxicated drivers will be evicted form the campsite and reported to authorities.
